Things to do in Varna

Landmarks & Monuments

Iconic structures showcasing Varna's rich history and architectural heritage along the Black Sea coast.



Varna Cathedral (Alexander Nevsky Cathedral) Must See

A majestic Orthodox cathedral built in honor of Alexander Nevsky, featuring **golden domes** and stunning Byzantine architecture. Completed in 1907, the cathedral dominates Varna's skyline and serves as one of Bulgaria's most important religious monuments with intricate interior mosaics and ornate iconography.

Dormition of the Mother of God Church Top Pick

Monument to the Exiled Top Pick

A poignant **monumental sculpture** commemorating Bulgarian exiles, located in the Sea Garden. The dramatic stone figures convey themes of displacement and longing, offering both artistic and historical significance while providing scenic viewpoints over the harbor.

Tips for Landmarks & Monuments

- Visit cathedrals early morning for peaceful atmosphere
- Photography is allowed in most churches; respect prayer times
- Dress modestly when entering religious sites
- Many monuments are illuminated beautifully at night



Museums & Galleries

World-class museums featuring archaeological treasures, art collections, and maritime heritage exhibits.



Varna Archaeological Museum

Naval Museum

Old Town (Medieval District)

- Visit archaeological sites with a knowledgeable guide for deeper understanding

Vasil Levski Square (Central Square) Must See

Independence Square (Women's Bazaar Square) Top Pick

- Safe for walking at all hours but busier during day

Practical Information

Ideal Visiting Seasons

June-September offer warm, sunny weather perfect for beach activities with temperatures 25-28°C. Water temperatures peak at 23-24°C in August, ideal for swimming and water sports.

May and October provide pleasant weather (18-23°C) with fewer tourists, ideal for cultural exploration and outdoor activities without heat intensity.

November-March experiences cooler temperatures (5-10°C) with occasional rain, but offers peace, lower prices, and clear skies for autumn/winter photography.

Avoid July-August if crowd-sensitive—peak season brings maximum tourists to beaches and major attractions, with premium pricing and potential overcrowding.

Getting Around Varna

Public Buses & Minibuses: Extensive network covering entire city with affordable fares (1-2 BGN). Purchase tickets from kiosks or aboard. Most buses operate 5 AM-midnight.

Taxis: Metered yellow taxis available everywhere. Use Vitosha Taxi or call 7777 for reliability. Uber available in limited capacity. Always verify meter engagement.

Bicycle Rental: Bike-sharing system 'Bike Varna' and rental shops throughout city. Perfect for Sea Garden exploration and flat urban areas.

Walking: Compact historic center easily walkable. Sea Garden waterfront ideal for strolling.

Car Rental: International agencies at airport and city center. Driving requires EU license or International Driving Permit. Roads generally good; parking available but challenging in center.

Airport Transfer: Sofia Varna Airport 10km away. Bus line 409 to center (1.5 hours), shuttle vans (30 minutes), or prearranged airport transfers available.

➔ Airport Transfer

Varna Airport (VAR) to city center:

- **Bus 409:** Public bus to Varna city center in about 30 minutes, 1.60 BGN
- **Taxi:** Metered taxi to city center in 15-20 minutes, around 15-20 BGN
- **Private transfer:** Pre-booked door-to-door transfer to city center or Golden Sands resort in 20-30 minutes, roughly 40-60 BGN
- **Car rental:** Pick up at the arrivals hall and drive to the city center in about 15 minutes, from 60 BGN per day



What to Buy & Where to Shop

Traditional Souvenirs: Rose water products from Kazanlak, essential oils, crafts. Markets: Women's Bazaar (Independence Square), craft shops in Old Town.

Jewelry: Bulgarian rose gold and silver jewelry at excellent prices. Vetrnica Street features quality jewelers with authentic traditional designs.

Wine & Spirits: Local wine from Thrace region vineyards. Rakija (fruit brandy) and plum spirits. Specialized wine shops throughout city.

Textiles: Handwoven carpets, embroidered linens, and traditional folk costumes from mountain artisans available at markets and craft galleries.

Modern Shopping: Varna Center Mall and Paradise Center offer international brands and local boutiques. Seaside boutiques feature designer goods.

Markets: Women's Bazaar (daily except Sunday, 8 AM-3 PM) for traditional crafts, clothing, souvenirs. Fish market (morning) for fresh seafood.

Bargaining: Normal in street markets and bazaars. Expect to negotiate 10-20% off initial prices in traditional markets. Fixed pricing in stores and malls.

Annual Events & Celebrations

Varna Summer Theater Festival (June-September): International theater performances in open-air venues throughout city, featuring Bulgarian and European productions.

Spirit of Burgas Sea Fest (August): Weekend music festival with international and local artists, food stalls, and beach activities.

Varna Jazz Festival (September): Premier jazz event attracting world-class musicians and lovers to outdoor and indoor venues.

Golden Sands Film Festival (August-September): Cinema celebration at nearby resort with international and Bulgarian productions, masterclasses.

Easter Orthodox Celebrations (April/May): Solemn religious processions, traditional foods, and candlelit evening services in churches citywide.

National Day of Enlightenment (May 24): Parades, educational events, and celebrations of Bulgarian culture and Cyrillic script.

New Year (December-January): Street celebrations, concerts, fireworks display over Sea Garden, holiday markets.

5-Day Sample Itinerary

Day 1 - History & Culture: Begin at Archaeological Museum (2 hours) exploring world's oldest gold treasure. Lunch in Old Town. Afternoon stroll through medieval streets photographing architecture. Evening: visit Alexander Nevsky Cathedral (45 min), sunset at Sea Garden promenade, dinner at waterfront restaurant.

Day 2 - Maritime & Monuments: Morning at Naval Museum exploring Bulgarian naval history (1.5 hours). Lunch at Sea Garden café. Afternoon bicycle tour through Sea Garden (2 hours) visiting sculpture park and themed gardens. Evening: Dancing Fountains show, casual dinner in Mladost District bohemian neighborhood.

Day 3 - Beach Day Adventure: Breakfast then day trip to Golden Sands Beach Resort (20 min north) for swimming and sunbathing. Try water sports or relax beachside. Sunset return to Varna, visit Constanza Casino for evening ambiance, dinner at fish restaurant near Vinetsa beach.



Day 4 - Nature & Archaeology: Boat tour along Black Sea coast (3 hours) with potential dolphin sightings. Lunch at harbor. Afternoon visit Balchik Botanical Garden (40 min) exploring terraced plants and clifftop palace. Return via scenic route. Evening exploration of contemporary galleries in Mladost, live music venue.

Day 5 - Leisure & Surrounding Areas: Morning visit Srebarna Nature Reserve for bird watching (30 min drive). Afternoon drive to Kaliakra Cape for fortress ruins and dramatic clifftop walks (1 hour south). Return for final sunset Sea Garden stroll, farewell dinner at traditional Bulgarian restaurant sampling regional specialties.

Best Photography Locations & Timing

Sea Garden at Sunset (6-8 PM spring/summer): Golden light illuminates monuments, trees, and water. Telephoto lens ideal for sea reflections. Dancing fountains create dramatic evening light show.

Alexander Nevsky Cathedral Exterior (Morning 7-9 AM): Side-lit golden domes glow beautifully. Blue-hour photography pre-sunrise captures dramatic sky and illuminated cathedral against darkness.

Old Town Cobblestone Streets (Early Morning 6-8 AM): Soft directional light creates dramatic shadows on historic architecture. Minimal tourist crowds for clean shots. Afternoon backlighting highlights worn architectural details.

Black Sea Coastal Cliffs (Golden Hour 5-7 PM): Kaliakra Cape and clifftop areas offer dramatic landscape photography. Seascape compositions with sunset light across water. Use wide-angle lenses for epic scope.

Harbor & Fishing Boats (Pre-dawn 5-7 AM): Moody light reflects off calm morning water. Fishing boats create foreground interest with colorful vessels. Fog often adds atmospheric depth.

Balchik Botanical Garden (Overcast Days or Golden Hour): Rare plants photograph well without harsh shadows. Terraced layout creates layered composition depth. Late afternoon side-lighting highlights textures.

Street Art Mladost District (Bright Overcast or Morning): Overcast light eliminates harsh shadows on murals. Morning sunlight creates directional interest. Use fast film for low-light evening neon effects.

Dancing Fountains (Evening 8-10 PM): Colored lights and water create abstract patterns. Long exposures blur water motion artistically. Foreground silhouettes add composition depth.

Power & Voltage Information

Standard Voltage: Bulgaria uses 230V AC at 50Hz frequency, significantly higher than North American 120V. Check all electronics for dual-voltage capability before plugging in.

Outlet Types: Predominantly Type C (European two-round-pin) outlets. Some newer buildings feature Type E or Type F variants (three-round-pin configurations). Most visitor areas standardized on Type C.

Adapters Required: North American (Type A, B), UK (Type G), and Australian (Type I) visitors require travel adapters. USB adapters work universally and charges effectively for phones/tablets.

Adapter Sources: Purchase before departure or at airport shops. Electronic stores and hotel front desks supply adapters for guest use, often complimentary.

Safety Tips: Use surge protectors for valuable electronics. Outlets often poorly grounded; limit multiple appliances simultaneously. Never force incompatible plugs into outlets.

Power Reliability: Infrastructure reliable throughout city. Occasional outages during winter storms possible but rare. Coastal areas highly stable.

Culinary Specialties & Dining Guide

Must-Try Bulgarian Dishes: *Shopska Salad* (tomato, cucumber, cheese) - refreshing staple. *Banitsa* (phyllo pastry with cheese) - flaky breakfast favorite. *Kebab* (seasoned meat skewer) - street food staple. *Snezhanka* (yogurt, cucumber,



garlic) - refreshing cold soup.

Black Sea Specialties: Fresh mussels and oysters harvested daily. Grilled sea bass and sea bream. Shrimp prepared simply with lemon. Calamari and octopus in traditional preparation. Fish roe salads (tarama) as appetizers.

Regional Wines: Rose wine from Thrace region (light, floral). Red wines from Burgas area (fruity, medium-bodied). Local rakija fruit spirits (homemade varieties vary widely).

Where to Eat: Old Town restaurants offer traditional atmosphere. Sea Garden waterfront venues provide views with meals. Mladost District hosts trendy contemporary restaurants. Fish markets near harbor for authentic local seafood.

Dining Tips: Lunch typically 12-3 PM (main meal). Dinner after 8 PM (3-4 hours). Tipping 10-15% standard for good service. Cash payments expected at many establishments; cards increasingly accepted. Street food (grilled corn, roasted chestnuts, pastries) widely available and inexpensive.
