Landmarks & Monuments

Iconic structures that define Kolkata's skyline and represent its historical significance and architectural heritage.



Must See

Victoria Memorial

A stunning white marble monument built in 1906 honoring Queen Victoria. This architectural masterpiece features Indo-British design with beautifully manicured gardens. The museum inside houses historical artifacts, photographs, and royal memorabilia spanning several centuries.

Howrah Bridge

An iconic cantilever bridge opened in 1943, connecting Kolkata and Howrah. This architectural marvel is one of the busiest bridges in the world. The bridge offers stunning views of the Hooghly River and is particularly magical during sunset and evening illumination.

Practical Information

Best Time to Visit

October to February is the ideal period with pleasant weather, lower humidity, and comfortable temperatures (15-28°C). This season aligns with major festivals including Durga Puja (September-October) and Kolkata Book Fair (January-February). **March to May** experiences high temperatures (28-38°C) and is less comfortable for sightseeing. **June to September** brings monsoon rains, making outdoor activities challenging but offering lush green landscapes.

Peak Tourist Season: October-November sees maximum visitors when weather is optimal and festivals occur. Book accommodations in advance during this period.

Getting Around Kolkata

- **Metro Rail:** Efficient, air-conditioned system covering major tourist spots. Tokens or smart cards available at stations. Operates 6 AM-10:30 PM.
- **Buses:** Extensive public bus network covering entire city. Board from designated bus stops. Air-conditioned and non-AC options available.
- **Yellow Taxis:** Metered taxis available throughout city. Negotiate fare in advance if meter unavailable. Can arrange through hotels.
- **Auto-rickshaws:** Three-wheeled vehicles for short distances. Metered or negotiable fares. Common in residential areas.
- **Cycle-rickshaws:** Traditional transport in older parts of city. Scenic but slower option for short distances.
- **Rental Cabs:** Apps and agencies offer self-drive or chauffeur options. Useful for multi-day city tours.
- **Ferries:** River ferries across Hooghly River connecting Kolkata and Howrah. Economical and scenic option.

➔ Airport Transfer

Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose International Airport (CCU) to city center:

- **Prepaid Taxi:** Government-booth taxi to central Kolkata in about 45 minutes, roughly ₹400-500
- **WBTC AC Volvo Bus:** Airport bus to Esplanade or Howrah in 60-90 minutes depending on traffic, around ₹40-60
- **App Cab (Ola/Uber):** Door-to-door ride to city center in 40-60 minutes, typically ₹350-600
- **Private Transfer:** Pre-booked car with driver to your hotel in 45 minutes, fixed rate around ₹1200-1500

Electrical Information

Voltage & Frequency: India uses 230V, 50Hz electrical supply. Significantly different from US 110V/60Hz and European 220V/50Hz systems.

Plug Types: India primarily uses Type D plugs (three round pins in triangular arrangement). Also common are Type A (two flat pins), Type F (round pins with side grounding clips), and Type M (three thick round pins).

Adapters & Converters: International visitors should carry universal power adapters compatible with Type D plugs. Most Indian hotels provide adapters at reception. Electronic devices with dual voltage capability (check labeling) only need adapters. Non-dual voltage devices require voltage converters (heavy and not recommended).

Power Supply: Generally reliable in tourist areas and modern hotels. Occasional power cuts possible, especially monsoon season. Hotels usually have backup generators. Carry portable chargers for continuous device availability.
